

TOWN OF ARLEY
ORDINANCE 2023-002
LITTER ORDINANCE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ARLEY,
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or deposit litter upon any street or other public place within the municipal limits or police jurisdiction of the Town of Arley,

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw candy or other objects to individuals in crowds watching parades in the Town, and no person shall throw litter to include candy, beads, or other organic or non-organic matter or objects while participating in conjunction with parades on the streets or roads in the Town of Arley or its police jurisdiction; provided, however, the distribution of such items by individuals being hand-delivered to recipients during a parade shall not be included,

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove or cause to be removed from any street or sidewalk in the Town any receptacle furnished by the Town of Arley for the deposit of trash. It shall be unlawful for any person to deface any such receptacle or to cause it to be used in any way which will make it inaccessible for the receipt of trash. It shall be unlawful for any person to place, store or cause to be placed or stored any goods, merchandise, lumber, rubbish or other material near or in any such receptacle in such manner as to interfere with or prevent the use of any such receptacle for the purpose which it is intended to serve,

Section 4. Any person violating the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

ORDINANCE 2023-001

NOISE ORDINANCE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ARLEY,
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to make, continue, or cause to be made or continued any loud or excessive noise which unreasonably interferes with the comfort, health or safety of others within the municipal limits or police jurisdiction of the Town of Arley, Alabama, in between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

Section 2. It is hereby declared a nuisance and shall be unlawful to operate or play any radio, or recorded music, or sound player, or amplifier, musical instrument, or similar device which produces or reproduces sound, from any motor vehicle on a public right-of-way or by a pedestrian, in such a manner as to be plainly audible to any person other than the player or operator of the device at a distance of five feet in the case of a motor vehicle or ten feet in the case of a pedestrian. For the purposes of this provision, a pedestrian is considered to be any person occupying an outdoor public space or right-of-way. This provision shall not apply in the following instance(s):

When such sound is produced within the designated area of a town-sanctioned event, during the official hours of said event.

Section 3. It is hereby declared a nuisance and shall be unlawful to operate or play any radio, television, recorded music or sound player or amplifier, musical instrument, or similar device which produces or reproduces sound from private property, whether indoors or outdoors, in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet to any person, except that this provision shall not apply in the following instance(s):

When such sound is produced within the designated area of a town-sanctioned event, during the official hours of said event.

When such sound is produced within a business zone between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

Section 4. Any person violating the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not to exceed ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. This article shall not be construed as prohibiting the production of music or noise pursuant to an event, parade, assembly or other permit authorizing the same and issued by the city council or other authorized official or agent of the Town of Arley, Alabama or by any official school event.

Section 6. Nothing in this article shall be construed to prohibit the ringing of bells or chimes by churches within the town.

Section 7. Nothing in this article shall be construed to prohibit any noises or sound produced by radios, sirens, or other equipment attached to, or being operated by, any police, fire, rescue, or other emergency vehicles or personnel.

Section 8. Nothing in this article shall be construed to prohibit the conducting of live remote broadcasts by duly licensed radio stations upon business premises, at the request of the owner of the business. Said live remote broadcasts shall be limited to daylight hours only.

Section 9. Each and every violation of any provision of this article shall constitute a separate offense.
